Leaders know who represents them in public office and become engaged in the civic process. What are you passionate about? What can you improve through the civic process?

If you're in grades 9-12, enter this letter writing competition. Qualified entries are entered into a drawing for the chance to win a ticket to attend Hamilton with one of your elected officials on April 19 or April 21.

CONTEST RULES

The contest is limited to one entry per student. Every entry must meet the following criteria:

- Select one elected official that represents you.
- Select a subject category.
- Write a letter that educates your elected official about your issue and proposes a solution or improvement.
- Send the letter using the online form.

SELECTION CRITERIA

Winners will be drawn randomly.

WHO GETS TICKETS

Each Legislative district, Salt Lake City Council district, and Salt Lake County Council district is allocated four tickets:

- Two tickets for the elected official and their partner or adult guest
- Two tickets for students residing in the elected official's district.

REIMBURSABLE COSTS

Winning students and guardians that travel more than 50 miles from Salt Lake City are encouraged to request reimbursement for costs.
